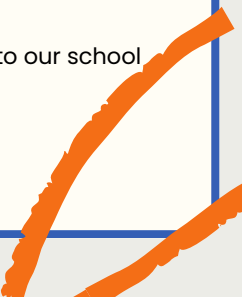

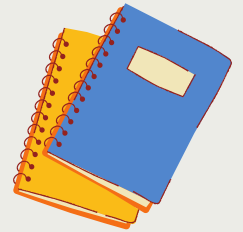


# ATTENDANCE
